RE: Federal Fiscal Year 2020 Child and Adult Care Food Program Meal and
Supplement Reimbursement Rates **and Cash-In-Lieu Rate**

DATE: September 9, 2019

PURPOSE: This memorandum provides all Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) Service Providers the Rates of Reimbursement established by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2020 beginning July 1, 2019 - June 30, 2020.

FFY2020 Reimbursement Rates are to be published in Federal Register on 08/07/2019 and available online at <https://federalregister.gov/d/2019-16907>, and on govinfo.gov. Attached for reference is the Department of Agriculture 2019-2020 Meal Reimbursement Notice Billing Code 3410-30-P.

IMPLEMENTATION: All CACFP Service Providers must utilize the FFY2020 rates of reimbursement beginning July 1, 2019. The rates of reimbursement for the CACFP effective July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020 are as follows:

	Breakfast	Lunch	Supplement/Snack(s)
Free (A)	1.84	3.41	0.94
Reduced-Price (B)	1.54	3.01	0.47
Paid(C)	0.31	0.32	0.08

The above rates do not include the value of commodities or cash-in-lieu of commodities which centers can receive as additional assistance for each lunch or supper served to participants if you choose to receive cash rather than donated commodities. ***The cash-in-lieu of commodities has been published and established at \$0.2375 for each lunch and supper meal served to enrolled clients.***
