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OASAC CCP Medicaid Enrollment Oversight Subcommittee

*Pursuant to **Public Act 100-0587**, within the Older Adult Services Advisory Committee (OASAC), The Department on Aging has been tasked with the creation of **The Community Care Program (CCP) Medicaid Oversight Subcommittee**.*

The Department on Aging, with the involvement of the Subcommittee, must collaborate with the Department on Healthcare and Family Services on how best to achieve the responsibilities of the Community Care Program Medicaid Initiative. The Subcommittee must collaborate with the Department of Human Services on the adoption of a uniform application submission process.

The Department on Aging must provide the following data sets to the Subcommittee:

- 1. The number of Illinois residents, categorized by Planning and Service Area (PSA), who are receiving services under CCP and are enrolled in the Medicaid.*
- 2. The number of Illinois residents, categorized by PSA, who are receiving services under CCP, but are not enrolled in Medicaid.*
- 3. The number of Illinois residents, categorized by PSA, who are receiving services under CCP, and are eligible for benefits under Medicaid, but are not enrolled in Medicaid.*

In addition, the Department must provide the Subcommittee with plans on how the Department will reduce the number of Illinois residents who are not enrolled in Medicaid but are eligible for Medicaid.

This OASAC CCP Medicaid Enrollment Oversight Subcommittee will make recommendations on how best to increase the number of medical assistance recipients who are enrolled in the Community Care Program. This Subcommittee will meet quarterly for the next 5 years.

The Department on Aging must provide an enhanced rate to adequately compensate Care Coordination Units to enroll CCP participants into the State's Medical Assistance Program (Medicaid); use recommendations from stakeholder committee on how best to implement the Initiative, and establish requirements for the State agencies to make enrollment for Medicaid easier for seniors

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
