GCP HOMECARE AIDE QUALIFICATIONS

Meet 1 of the following:

- High school diploma or GED
- Working towards a GED with a grade of C or higher
- One year of employment in a similar human service capacity
- One year of experience with caregiving, including caring for dependent children and adult family members

Employees will receive training on homecare topics and skills.

- 24 hours of pre-service training
- 12 hours of training annually
