Welcome and IntroductionSandra Alexander
Phyllis Mitzen moved to approve the minutes from the January 13, 2014 Executive meeting, Terri Harkin second. Minutes were approved.

Follow up re: Stakeholder Engagement ProcessSandra Alexander
OASAC Priorities for 2014-2015 and Recommended Stakeholder Engagement Process document was reviewed and next steps for OASAC were discussed. The Executive Committee questioned the involvement of consumers (program recipients) during policy development and tried to identify ways to increase consumer input. Current methods for consumer input were discussed and the group agreed that a new mechanism for consumer input is needed. Next steps for group will be to identify all mechanisms being used; look at additional opportunities (build on the mechanisms that already exist to avoid duplication) and make sure that Advisory Groups have consumers at the table. The group agreed to add measurements under the Recommended Stakeholder Engagement Process to determine the effectiveness.
