


# Healthcare Voting: Facilities' Responsibilities



## Who is required to participate?

### Federally Operated Facilities:

- Veterans' homes
- Hospitals

If you're not sure if this applies to you, please contact your county. 

### Facilities licensed or certified pursuant to the Nursing Home Care Act (210 ILCS 45)

### Facilities under the ID/DD Community Care Act (210 ILCS 47)

### Facilities under the Specialized Mental Health Rehabilitation Act of 2013 (210 ILCS 49)

### Facilities under the MC/DD Act (210 ILCS 46)

## What is required?

- Coordinate with the Election Authority (EA) at least 30 days before each regular election.
- Provide a convenient time in the period on the Friday, Saturday, Sunday or Monday immediately before Election Day for voting on the premises of the facility.
- Post the agreed time and place somewhere prominent for notice no later than 30 before the election. (10 ILCS 5/19-12.2)

## What will happen?

- Two Election Judges will come to the facility.
- The EA will provide voting booths or screens to ensure the privacy of the voter to the maximum extent possible.
- Voting will be conducted during a continuous period sufficient to allow all applicants to cast their ballots.

### PLEASE NOTE:

Any voter admitted to your facility no more than that 14 days before the election shall be entitled to personal delivery of a ballot, including voters released before Election Day if they are homebound. (10 ILCS 5/19-13)
