Spread the Word: On Jan. 1, 2024, More People will Save on Medicare Costs with Expansion of “Extra Help”

On Jan. 1, 2024, more people with Medicare will benefit from the Extra Help program. Extra Help lowers Medicare drug coverage (Part D) costs, like premium deductibles, and coinsurance for those who apply and qualify. The drug pricing law expanded Extra Help so more people with Medicare will qualify for the full subsidy under the program.

In 2024, everyone who qualifies for Extra Help will pay:

- \$0 for their Medicare drug plan premium.
- \$0 for their plan deductible.
- A reduced amount for both generic and brand-name drugs.
